

Kayak Policy

Board of Directors Meeting – October 27, 2015

The owner(s) of kayaks, canoes, and SUP's are required to make sure that when stored the equipment is secured in such a way as to not float or be blown from the storage location. Should the equipment be stored below a unit other than the kayaks, canoes or SUP's owner(s) unit, then the equipment owner shall obtain written permission to store said equipment at another owner's unit or area near the unit. The document should be given to the property manager to be kept on file.

Prior to Hurricane Season

All kayak, paddle boards or other watercraft placed underneath terraces (common area) should be properly secured and the Association notified if you are leaving for the season. The unit care person should be aware they are responsible to adding extra ropes in case of a pending storm or relocate the craft to an interior location.
